

## New Campus Housing Options Starting Fall 2021

Beginning in the Fall 2021 semester, all living quarters on the campus of Randall University will be considered “on-campus” housing. These buildings include Yandell Hall, Friends Hall, Wiley Hall (A dorm), Barnard Hall (B dorm), the Apartments, and the Duplex.

A student’s room will be charged to their account each semester according to the following chart. Chares are broken down by two criteria: building and the occupancy of each room/unit.

Toilet paper, paper towels, hand soap, trash bags, and cleaning supplies are provided by the university. All utilities are included in the dorm charge.

After enrolling for the Fall semester, students will be able to select their top three choices, specifying building/occupancy and roommate preference by visiting [ru.edu/housing](http://ru.edu/housing). The Dean of Students and Resident Life staff will do their best to accommodate each student based on the three choices submitted. In the case that none of the three choices are possible, the student will be contacted to discuss further plans. When a student is assigned a room, they will be notified via email.

If a student moves out of their dorm *before* the add/drop date, their charges will be prorated according to the amount of time spent in the dorm. If a student moves out of their dorm *after* the add/drop date, **no refund will be given** or applied to their account.

Each student will be charged a \$250 deposit that can be fully refunded after moving out of their room if they return their key and leave their dorm clean and free of damages. Any damage incurred by the student will be charged to their account.

All students living in campus housing are required to purchase a meal plan (minimum of 40 meals per semester).

All residents in the dormitories are subject to abide by the rules and regulations set forth in the most current edition of the Randall University Student Handbook.
